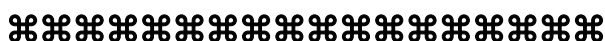

- * In India they were known as temple trees by Buddhists, resembling immortality because of the way a branch can easily be snapped off to re-grow and flower.
- * Aztec Indians used it for medical purposes
- * Caribbean's use the leaves as a wrap to heal bruises
- * Hindus offered the flowers to their gods
- * Some other cultures such as Bengali, the white flowers were associated with funerals or death
- * These flowers may be found in graveyards in the Philippines or Indonesia, because of the belief that this plant would shelter ghosts.
- * In Hawaii it is the symbol of eternal life-forms; also used as a Lei flower.
- * In Feng Shui the flower is related with love
- * Polynesian women wear the flower in their hair to represent relationship status.

RECIPE CORNER

Creamy Pumpkin Soup

1 onion (chopped finely)
500gms pumpkin (peeled and chopped)
1 packet Cream of Chicken Soup
½ cup cream
2 Tablespoons butter
3 cups of water
½ teaspoon nutmeg

Fry onion in butter until soft. Add pumpkin, cover and sauté for 5 minutes. Add soup mix and water. Simmer until pumpkin is tender approximately 15 minutes. Cool then puree. Stir in cream and nutmeg. Reheat without boiling. Serve hot sprinkled with chopped parsley.

Jelly Slice

1 packet Scotch Finger Biscuits
1 tin condensed milk
4 teaspoons gelatine
2 cups of boiling water
125gms butter
2 Tablespoons lemon juice
2 packets raspberry jelly

Crush biscuits, melt butter and mix together until combined. Spread biscuit mixture over base of slice container.

Mix 2 teaspoons of the gelatine with 2/3 cup warm water. Add gelatine mixture to condensed milk and lemon juice. Beat with electric mixer until combined. Pour mixture over biscuit base and place in refrigerator until set.

Mix dry jelly crystals with 2 teaspoons gelatine. Add jelly crystals and gelatine mixture to 2 cups of boiling water mix to dissolve. Stand jelly in refrigerator until just starting to set, then pour over biscuit and cream mixture. Place back in fridge to set.

Handy Hint.

To clean oven shelves. Soak for 1 hour in Nappy San dissolved in hot water. Shelves will come out nice and shiny and easy to clean
